
Materials Needed:

- Crayons (8 Basic Colors)

Directions:

Each student is to be given a copy of the large picture that matches the picture on this page. Students should only work on the large picture. Sentences are to be read aloud to the students, allowing adequate time for each direction to be completed. The sentences may be repeated if necessary.



- 1. The dinosaurs are catching butterflies. All the butterflies should be colored yellow.
- 2. The largest dinosaur should be colored green and have purple eyes. Its nails should all be colored yellow.
- 3. Far back in the picture is another dinosaur standing on its hind legs. Color it and all the tree leaves green.
- 4. The middle-sized dinosaur is about to trip over a rock. Draw a big rock in front of it.
- 5. The butterflies seem to like the plants at the bottom of the page. Circle the plants that have butterflies on them.
- 6. You have already found three dinosaurs. Look carefully and you will find another one. Color it orange.
- 7. Make a yellow sun in the sky and we will know it is a sunny day.
- 8. Draw a small turtle dinosaur near the largest dinosaur.
