INSTRUCTIONS

Print and cut out each card from pages 4-9. Print and cut out the checkmarks from pages 14 & 15. Print out and laminate the game boards (pages 10-13). Stack the question cards and place them facedown. Have each student pick a game board. Each student then takes turns picking cards. If the student answers the card correctly, he/she gets to pick a check mark (same color as the card answered) and place it on his/her board. Once all the boxes are filled, that student wins!
