
Directions: Give the child a copy of the picture scene on page 35, and the pictures below. Have the child color and cut out all of the pictures.

Activity: Ask the child to listen carefully. Read the following directions aloud. Put a \checkmark in each box to easily track the child's progress.


- ☐ Find the chair and the thermos. Glue the chair next to the tent and the thermos near the fire.
